CAFOD collection for Ethiopia: there is currently a serious food crisis in Ethiopia that has left over 10 million people facing severe food shortages. The El Nino effect is worsening causing flash floods in Ethiopia and the rains have failed twice. As a result, the last harvest failed and the next will not yield anything like enough food either. Some 400,000 children are suffering from malnutrition. CAFOD have been supporting the emergency response as part of the Caritas network and to this end we will holding a retiring collection this weekend **11th/12th June** for the crisis in Ethiopia.
