**Second Collection this weekend of 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> September** will be for the Kerala Flood appeal at all Mass centres through the St Francis Syro-Malabar Community at St Peter's – please give as generously as you can and keep all our parishioners affected by this terrible ordeal in your prayers.

**Kerala Floods: an SVP Appeal** as you've probably seen in the media, terrible floods have been taking place in Kerala in Southern India. Hundreds of people have been killed and many more are missing; countless homes have been washed away, and the monsoon season is set to continue until early September. Kerala is the most Christian state in India – it has more churches than any other region.
