

# Rules for logo competition

## “St. Mary’s Church”

### Institution

St. Mary’s Catholic Church, Regent Road, Great Yarmouth. NR30 2AJ

### Objective of the competition

To choose a “logo” to represent St Mary’s Church and the Heritage Fund Application to restore the Church and preserve it for the future generations.

### Project

Design a Logo that will be fit to use for all things where a Logo would be used from letterheads, badges, medals, posters clothing etc with a view to raising funds for the parish contribution to any funding the parish might get to help with the work.

### Topic for the logo

The topic should be a representation of anything that shows the cultures and countries represented in St. Mary’s Church.

The theme for our Heritage Lottery bid is “A safe haven for 50 Nations.”

### Participants

All members of the congregation at St. Mary’s are eligible to participate in our Logo Competition.

### Technical details

1. The design must be original and not edited before.
2. The technique used can be free: drawing, painting, computer design, photography, all adaptable to printing.
3. They must be presented in A4 and the dimension of the logo will be the maximum 15x15 cm, which does not imply that it should be a square shape.
4. The final design having been done on the computer, the electronic version must be presented in addition.
5. The logo may include the words “A safe haven for 50 Nations.”
6. The proposal will be accompanied by a brief explanation of the design and the main ideas represented (on a separate paper).

## Dates

By Sunday July 28, 2019 at 21:00 all entries must be submitted to the Rectory in an envelope clearly marked for the attention of the Parish Pastoral Council.

The final judging will take place between the 29 July and the 2 August 2019. The winner will be revealed at 11:00 mass on Sunday 11 August 2019.

Your electronic version of your design can be sent to the [logo@stmarysgy.org.uk](mailto:logo@stmarysgy.org.uk) mailbox. Please include your Name, Address, Phone number and Age in the email. If you prefer, you can include a memory stick with your design on.

## Prize

The winner's logo will be used on St Mary's new website, mentioning the winner's name. It will also be published in the Parish Newsletter every week and used wherever it is deemed fit to be used. The winner will receive a Token prize from the Parish Council.

## Acceptance

The participation in the competition implies the acceptance of these terms, as well as the criteria and the judges' final decision.

## Copyright

The designs of the presented logos must be unpublished and directly created for this competition. Authorisation will be applied to those presented projects in this competition. All the selected projects will be able to be reproduced and shown to the public.

In all cases mentioned before, reference to the authors of the designs should be made. The authorisation implies that the publication will not generate any retribution, and the copyright will be given to St. Mary's Church, Regent Road, Great Yarmouth. NR30 2AJ who organised the competition.
