Mass with Social Distancing: We have been working towards the opening of the church for public Mass. During this pandemic, we now have an additional **6 pm Mass** on Saturday at St. Peter's and **9 am Mass** at St. Mary's to help accommodate more people at Mass. It will be quite different to what we have been used to and we will need many of you to pitch in and help in a variety of ways. In line with the social distancing, parishioners must be on their face coverings and the maximum number for St. Peter is 42. Please, we ask parishioners to tell us which Mass they will come to and how many will be in their household. **Please, call or email us in this regard.** The days and times for masses in our churches are thus: **ST MARY'S** from **Tuesday to Saturday – 10:00 (Mass) and the church closes for the day to re-open the next day for mass. ST PETER'S** from **Tuesday to Saturday – 10:00 (Mass) and 19:00 on Thursday.**

We will require two stewards on duty at all times. Thus, the two parishes are still asking for those who can volunteer as Stewards for any of the two parishes to please, ring the rectory and let us know if he/she would want to volunteer. Thanks!
