## NATIONAL EASTER SCENE SENIOR PAINTING COMPETITION 2020



This year, the Secondary Easter Scene Painting Competition is again grouped into two two Key Stage groups in High Schools and Parishes in East Anglia with Provincial prizes for the winners of each group in the Secondary stage The two groups are:

KS 3 - School Year Groups: 7, 8 and 9, (12 to 14 years of age),

KS 4 + School Year Groups: 10, 11, 12 and 13, (15 to 18 years of age).

As in 2019, winning entries of groups KS3 and 4 go forward to the National Final for judging. Please note the overall National Winner of KS3 & 4 will be the better winning entry of these High School groups combined.

*Please note, the school year grouping classification will be the prime age factor.*

Entries should depict a biblical scene of the entrant's choice of an incident recalled during the period from the start of the Easter Triduum, (Feast of the Lord's Supper), to the Feast of Pentecost.

*Remember, in addition to the important and popular scenes of the Last Supper, those recalling Christ's Passion on the first Good Friday and the Resurrection, there are the Journey to Emmaus, Appearances in the Upper Room and on the Shore of the Sea of Galilee, the Ascension, and Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Each tell a significant story for artists' talents!*

Entries may be sized A4 or A3, on paper of quality and colour of the entrant's choice.

Schools and Parishes are asked, where possible, to make a preliminary selection of entries and choose no more than four to go forward to the competition as there may be individual entries. All entries will be returned in due course. The following detail should be shown legibly in full on the reverse of each entry:

Name of entrant, Age of entrant, School Year Group. Name and full address of School/ Parish /Group attended, (eg Liturgy, Brownie or Cub Group etc). Signed by leader.

The awards after Provincial judging will be: Framed copies of the winning entries in each group, Certificates signed by the Provincial Great Knight and Cash Prizes of £7, £5 & £3 for 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places respectively.

The awards after National judging will be: Overall KS3 & 4 Winner: Engraved Trophy (Held by the school, group or individual for approximately one year), Certificates signed by the Supreme Knight, Cash Prizes of £75.00, £50.00 and £25.00 respectively for the best three winners at KS3 & KS4. Results will be announced in early Summer of 2020 and awards will be presented by arrangement with the winning school or parish and all entries returned.
