## NATIONAL EASTER SCENE JUNIOR PAINTING COMPETITION 2020



This year, the Easter Scene Painting Competition is again extended to pupils of Key Stage 2 in Schools and Parishes in East Anglia with Provincial and National prizes for the winners.

KS 2 - School Year Groups: 3, 4, 5, and 6, (8 to 11 years of age),

As in 2019, the winning entry of KS 2 group goes forward to the National Final for judging. The rules for KS3 & 4 groups are different and have been sent to the High Schools for their participation.

*Please note, the school year grouping classification will be the prime age factor.*

Entries should depict a biblical scene of the entrant's choice of an incident recalled during the period from the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, through the Easter Triduum, to the Feast of Pentecost. In addition to the important and popular scenes of the Last Supper, those recalling Christ's Passion on the first Good Friday and the Resurrection, there are the Journey to Emmaus, Appearances in the Upper Room and on the Shore of the Sea of Galilee, the Ascension, and Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. Each tell a significant story for artists' talents!

Entries may be sized A4 or A3, on paper of quality and colour of the entrant's choice. Schools and Parishes are asked, where possible, to make a preliminary selection of entries and choose no more than six to go forward to the competition. All entries will be returned in due course. The following detail should be shown legibly in full on the reverse of each entry:

Name of entrant, Age of entrant, School Year Group. Name and full address of School/ Parish /Group attended, (eg Liturgy, Brownie or Cub Group etc). & Leader.

The awards after Provincial judging will be:

Framed copies of the winning entries & Certificates signed by the Provincial Great Knight and Cash Prizes of £7.00, £5.00 & £3.00 for the best three in the opinion of the judges.

The awards after National judging will be: Certificates signed by the Supreme Knight & Cash Prizes of £30 and £20 for the winner and runner up with £200 for the winner's school.

Results will be announced in early Summer 2020 and awards will be presented by arrangement with the winning school or parish with all entries returned.
